Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we welcome Bishop David Evans to our parish as he celebrates the Sacrament of Confirmation at the 10.30am Mass on Sunday. The recipients are the children of Year 6 who attend our school and 3 children from the catechism class. Please keep them and all our children in your prayers.

Last Tuesday I attended the Reception and Mass of former parish priest of St Augustine's, Fr Fred Sheldon (1981-1991). Bishop David was the Chief Celebrant with a number of priests concelebrating. Fr Dominic informed us that the hymns we sang were those sung at Fr Fred's ordination mass. He was a late vocation and in his previous life he was an electrician. I bet that came in handy when he was a parish priest! I have left the Order of Service in the Narthex.

Fr Rob Taylerson is famous. Well, as you know all our former clergy are famous. Fr Rob is now a star on You Tube. I watched a presentation he gave about Creation which is his personal reflection and one of the themes for the Jubilee Year. I thought it was excellent and thought provoking. It is about 12 minutes.

The Comfirmandi came to two practices in the church last week. I thought they were well-behaved and prepared for the occasion. Every candidate for Confirmation has received the Sacrament of Confession (which was my task on Tuesday morning) after I had celebrated the Mass for the repose of the soul of Isabel Cusack. It was good to have the children with us at the Mass along with many of her fellow parishioners, friends and colleagues.

The maintenance of the church and site is ongoing. I am pleased to say last Thursday all the fire extinguishers were checked, serviced or replaced. After two years of wrangling with our electricity suppliers, an electrician came last Sunday morning to fix an isolator on the Presbytery fuse board. Having waited such a long time for this work to be done, I was not going to change what was for us an inconvenient day and time. It was an essential item to be fixed before the long overdue repairs for the house can begin. The monthly church maintenance collection will be taken today. Last year you raised £9900 and we had to spend £26,700. Prices have gone up and so I would ask you to keep this in mind for your contributions which are as always gratefully received.
